- We are unable to accept greyhounds on a raw or frozen diet.
- We are unable to accept greyhounds under 12 months of age.
- Applications will be managed on a first come, first served basis.
- Full payment is due when the booking is confirmed by Greyhound Trust Boarding.
- Should you cancel your booking with us, we are **not** able to offer a refund.

Terms and Conditions:

The booking request and any additional services required will be confirmed, via email, once the application has been received, processed and full payment has been taken. The booking will however be subject to proof of annual vaccinations, including vaccination against kennel cough, which must be done no later than two weeks before the scheduled boarding date and up-to-date parasite treatment. This information along with your greyhound's name should be emailed to <u>boarding@greyhoundtrust.org.uk</u> at least one week before arrival.

Any greyhound pairs must be from the same household and have an existing relationship. No more than two greyhounds will be boarded together.

Boarding is charged at £35 + VAT per day, a charge of £56 + VAT is applied for a sharing pair.

We reserve the right to decline any greyhounds that show signs of aggression towards other dogs or people. Furthermore, any greyhounds that have an existing injury or illness that we have not already been made aware of, may also be turned away.

We also reserve the right to deny future bookings, where we have assessed, during your dog's stay, that their welfare has been unreasonably compromised in a boarding kennel environment. This recognises that a level of 'normal/reasonable' stress can be expected, but when this moves to an unreasonable level, we would look to prioritise the welfare of the dog and not allow future bookings.

No liability is accepted for any loss, injury or illness to greyhounds boarded in our care and whilst your greyhound is in our care, you remain liable for the cost of any treatments or veterinary intervention that may be required, because of illness or injury. Should your greyhound become injured or ill whilst in the care of Greyhound Trust Boarding, they will be taken to our veterinary providers and be given the necessary treatments and/or medication, the cost of which will then be charged to you at the point of collection. All owners will be notified of any illness or injury costs incurred before collection.

No liability is accepted for any damage or theft to any vehicle parked at the National Greyhound Centre and vehicles and belongings are left at your own risk.

You must cover all expenses incurred during the boarding. For example, should your greyhound run out of food during their stay and Greyhound Trust Boarding has to purchase replacements, you will need to pay the invoice upon collection. You will however be made aware of the purchase before collection.

You must provide all your greyhound/s bedding, toys, feeding enrichment and food for the duration of their stay. They must also be boarded with their collar (preferably a fishtail collar), lead (non-



retractable) and muzzle for walking. Greyhounds will be fed as per their current diet and feeding regime, where possible. Please note, we can feed as early as 8am and as late as 4.00pm.

Any existing, long term medication, vitamins or supplements must also be provided and no additional charges will be made for the medication to be administered.

Your greyhound/s will have a minimum of four opportunities out of the bedroom a day. This can include, but not limited to, site walks, play time in our paddocks and relaxing time in our real-life rooms. Greyhounds will have access to enrichment toys and mental stimulation such as kongs, puzzle feeders and lick mats if required. They will not have direct contact with any of our homing greyhounds. They will be cared for daily, by a dedicated team member(s).

Should you not wish for your greyhound to have access to enrichment feeders such as kongs and lick mats; please opt out here

Our greyhound care team will send updates where possible. This will either be a picture or video alongside a short message update. Our care team will be unable to make daily phone calls or provide detailed updates via email.

If you do not wish to receive updates via WhatsApp ONLY, please opt out here

Whilst in our care, your greyhound will wear a blue house collar and a blue I.D tag.

Drop off's must be before 12pm (midday), the day boarding commences, and collections must be before 12pm (midday) on the last day of boarding. We would appreciate you arriving promptly at your chosen time, but if there are any issues, please ring the Centre and leave a message - 0204 599 7471.
